- · Animals being walked within the Borough are required to be leashed.
- Animals on private land must be contained to that property. If using a fence, fences for all dogs must be of sufficient height, strength, and repair to safely contain the dogs on the premises and to prevent children from entering the yard or enclosure. Underground fences are not sufficient to contain unsupervised dogs. Unsupervised dogs cannot be tethered as a primary method of confinement.

Dream and Fly with Scott Altman

FORMER NASA ASTRONAUT VISITS PAXTANG

Visit with Scott Altman, veteran Navy pilot and former NASA astronaut, as he recounts his experience, his dream to fly, his training to become an astronaut, being a 4-time crew member on the Space Shuttle, working to update and repair the Hubble space telescope, and his current work in the private sector on space systems. There will be plenty of time for Q & A. A special thanks to The Friends of Kline Library for providing funding support for this program.



Paxtang Borough will be installing another stormwater BMP near the intersection of Park Terrace and Brookwood Street. This Best Management Practice infiltration basin will be similar to the one completed near Park Terrace and Prince Street last year but on a smaller scale with a minimal number of trees being removed.

Similar to last years project, this project is planned, to meet the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4), requirements that the federal government has specified for municipalities. During each 5-year permit period we are required to meet certain standards and make improvements to our water quality. BMPs are structural, vegetative or managerial practices used to treat, prevent or reduce water pollution. They also help control flooding, reduce erosion and capture sediment while filtering the water on site.
